Raise the vehicle and put it on jack stands.

2

Remove the front wheels.

3

Loosen the bolts for the lower strut attachments.

Caution!


Support the wheel hubs in an appropriate way on each side of the vehicle so that the brake hoses can not be damaged.



Loosen the upper attachments. Remove the original struts from the car.

5

Cut the dust boot 62 mm from the lower end with a pair of scissors according to fig 2.





Note!

Remove the rubber spring isolator from the OE top mount according to fig 3.

6

Fit the dust boot (2), the plastic spacer (3), the spring (4), the elastic spacer (5), the spacer (6), the upper spring seat (7) the bearing (8), OE top mount, the washer (9) and the M12 lock nut (10) to the strut according to fig 1. Tighten the lock nut to 35 - 40 Nm. Adjust the spring seat and the lock ring according to fig 4 and tighten to 50 - 60 Nm.

Note!

When tightening the top mount nut, the shock absorber shaft must be held in position with an Allen key.

7

Fasten the upper attachments to the vehicle.

8

Raise the wheel hub with a jack to remove the freeplay of the lower strut attachment bolts before tightening them.

Note!


Make sure that all bolts are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the strut when it is being fully compressed or extended. Test this over the whole steering range from lock to lock.

9

Make sure that all removed parts are reinstalled in the same way as they were before the installation of the Öhlins shock absorber.

Note!

If the vehicle is equipped with OEM active shock absorbers, use Öhlins cancellation kit 35020-18.



ADJUSTMENTS



Remove the rear wheels.

3

Remove the lower and the upper attachments and remove the original shock absorbers and springs.


Cut the dust boot 62 mm from the lower end with a pair of scissors according to fig 2.



Adjust the length adjuster and tighten the lock nut according to fig 4.

6

Fit the top pin spacer (2), the dust boot (3), the OE top mount, the washer (4) and the M10 lock nut (5) and tighten to 30Nm. Install the adjustment knob (6) and tighten to 13Nm according to fig 1.





7

Install the Öhlins shock absorbers on the vehicle and fasten the upper attachments.

8

Mount the spring adjuster assembly in the control arm and install the upper OE spring seat on top of the spring.

9

Raise the wheel hub with a jack to remove the freeplay of the lower strut attachment bolts before tightening them.

10

Adjust the height adjuster according to fig 4 and tighten the lock ring with the c-spanners.

11


Make sure that all removed parts are reinstalled in the same way as they were before the installation of the Öhlins shock absorber.


